



### Year 10 Maths and Science Exams

The final common assessments for year 10 will take place the week commencing 10<sup>th</sup> June 2019 and last for 2 weeks.

All exams apart from Maths and Science will take place in classrooms under exam conditions.

In order to support our students in building their examination skills and resilience the Maths and Science exams will take place in the sports hall in formal exams conditions between the dates of Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2019.

During these exams students will be expected to abide by formal exam rules and regulations.

All students must bring all their own equipment and no toilet breaks will be allowed unless they have a medical reason and a toilet pass.

#### **Equipment required for Maths and Science exams are:**

2 black pens, 1 pencil, ruler, rubber, sharpener, protractor, compass, scientific calculator

*Highlighters may be used to highlight key information in the questions but not their final answers.*

If your child has specific access arrangements for exams then these will be catered for.

## Exam Rules and Regulations

- Exams are usually taken in the Sports Hall however if you have access arrangements then this may be different.
- Use the toilet before going into the exam hall as you may not be permitted to leave the venue once you have entered and the exam has started.
- You must enter the examination room **IN SILENCE** and **REMAIN SILENT** until you have left the examination room.
- Ensure your **MOBILE PHONE** is **SWITCHED OFF** and handed in at the start of the exam. (If your phone goes off in your bag you risk disqualification from the exam)
- **NO SMART WATCHES and all watches MUST be taken off and placed on your exam table**
- You are only permitted to take in a **SEE-THROUGH BOTTLE** containing **WATER** only and any labels should be removed
- All **pencil cases** must be **transparent** – use a polythene bag if necessary.
- Tell the invigilator at once:
  - If you think you have the wrong question paper or do not have the materials listed on the front of the paper.
  - If the question paper is incomplete or badly printed.
- Read carefully the instructions printed on the question paper and/or answer sheets and fill in the details required on the front before the start of the examination.
- You **must not** misuse exam material, copy, include inappropriate, offensive or obscene material in your exam script, draw on your exam script, be disruptive or use offensive language or disobey an invigilator. This could lead to disqualification from all of your exams.

**Failure to follow the rules of the examination room could lead to disqualification from one or more of your exams.**
