Dear Parents / Guardians,

We have been managing a dynamic situation over the weekend as we have been notified of positive cases and more staff who are experiencing symptoms and awaiting test results. I apologise for the lateness of this notification, but we have been working throughout the day to assess the situation.

So that we can continue our work with Public Health England and the Department for Education to ensure we have identified all close contacts and taken all the necessary actions **all students should remain at home Monday 12th October, 2020.**

To ensure the continuation of learning, students should access the Remote Learning section of the website where they will find details of how to access remote learning. All online lessons fall in-line with their current curriculum and so, loss of learning should be minimised. Students should follow their normal timetable for tomorrow, from home, and use the 'Staff Contact' page on the website (under Remote Learning), if they require contact with their teachers - who will be available to respond in their normal timetabled hour. Some staff members, who are not suffering from symptoms will deliver lessons remotely - and they will be in direct contact with your child to set this up.

Children of key workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend school and we will ensure that social distancing is in place, like the provision we ran previously. All children that fall into this category, and are attending this provision should register in the *hall at 8.30am*.

I will contact you tomorrow to inform you of the outcomes of our meetings.

Please rest assured that the move to the offer of off-site education tomorrow is a precautionary measure to ensure we are prioritising the safety of all. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
