



## **Mathematics COVID catch up**

Dear parent/carer,

Students have been working exceptionally hard over the lockdown period and I would first of all like to thank you for your support with this.

In order to determine what students have and have not understood during remote learning, students will be given a low stakes test in the first week back after half term in their mathematics lesson. The questions will be on topics that students would have been taught over the lockdown period. The results from these will be analysed and we will be inviting students to compulsory after school intervention based on any topics that they have not understood and would benefit from face to face teaching of these topics. The after school intervention will run from 15:05 – 16:00. Students will not be expected to go to every after school intervention and instead will go to the intervention for the topics that they had got incorrect on the test. Students will be informed with what sessions they will be attending and on what days once the results have been analysed. You will receive text messages before the day of the intervention session(s) that your son/daughter has been invited to. Please can you encourage your son/daughter to attend these.

In order to support your son/daughter, mathematics booklets have been given to students with examples on the topics that will be in the test and some practice questions to work through. This will hopefully help students to recap the content and not forget over the Easter break how to do those topics. These workbooks can also be found on TEAMS in year group folders if your son/daughter has misplaced them. Please encourage your son/daughter to complete these so that we can ensure that we are inviting the right students to the correct sessions
