



Minimum Expected Target Grades for Students at Tudor Grange Academy Kingshurst

It is important for all of our students to know what the minimum expectation of their GCSE grades is, all of the way through their learning journey at Kingshurst Academy.

All GCSEs subject are awarded levels from 9 – 1 rather than A* - G, so all Minimum Expected Target Grades are numerical.

All students Minimum Expected Target Grades are based on the KS2 fine level achieved at the end of Year 6. This is to match the national expectation of measuring student progress between two key points in a child's education: the national exams sat in Y6 – ‘SATS’ and the national exams sat in Y11 GCSEs.

After completing common assessments with all of the other students in their year group across the trust a 'projection grade' will be generated.

This trust 'projection grade' will be compared with the minimum expected target grade' to ensure students are on track with their progress.

- Omar is in Y7.
- He achieved roughly 100 for his SATs in Y6.
- He has a Minimum Expected Target grade of 5.
- He is set the target of getting 5s for all of his GCSE subjects in Y11.
