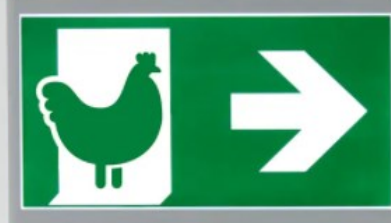

Thursday —Non-Uniform Day



Just a reminder that this Thursday (the final day of term) will see a non-uniform day.

All money raised (suggested donation £1) will be going towards supporting our local community and to the family of one of our students who have a 7 week old baby boy who requires an Endoscopic Strip Craniectomy operation. This procedure will be performed at Great Orman Street Hospital, London, and following this, the baby will be required to wear a specifically shaped protective helmet to protect his skull that costs several thousand pounds (and are not provided by the NHS).

Craniosynostosis is when the skull sutures fuse too early, impacting brain development and left untreated this can cause a series of life altering problems including brain damage.
